Michele Bowen, MA, LCSW: Michele Bowen specializes in adoption from all perspectives of the adoption triad. She received her MSW from Western Michigan University in 2005. She earned a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from Purdue University in 1994. Michele's areas of specialty include EMDR, DBT, working with complex trauma/grief and loss, addictions, anxiety, and depression.

Jessica Peachey, MA, LMHC: Jessica Peachey Bowen specializes in adoption from all perspectives of the triad. She received her MA in counseling in 2008 after completing her undergraduate work in Psychology in 2005, both from Grace College. Jessica's areas of specialty include anxiety, depression, and grief/loss.

Finances: Many times, insurance will cover a portion of sessions. If a client does not have insurance or insurance will not cover the cost of counseling services, Seasons Counseling has a <u>Client Assistance Fund</u>. However, if insurance does not cover visits and a client is not eligible for the Client Assistance Fund, the cost is \$145 for the initial session and \$110 for following sessions. Sessions generally last 45 minutes.

Vicki Heath is pre-licensed clinician with 25 + years of experience. She is a private practitioner and has experience providing counseling with birth mothers, adoptees, and adoptive families. Adoption is one of Vickie's specialty practices. She has also worked with those involved with the department of Child Services from CHINS thru adoption, Indiana courts and individual attorneys.

She believes in a client centered approach and focuses on the needs of the individual, adapting a therapy model based on that need. She believes that each person is made of complex layers of need and this may involve multiple modalities of treatment. She provides therapeutic services that work to resolve the safety up process. This means establishing a relationship in which clients feel safe, comfortable and willing to share so there can be movement thru complex needs. She focuses heavily on continuing education, understanding neurobiology, attachment, self-regulation, sensory processing, complex medical needs that affect mental health and working with providers in her community to maintain continuity of care. She utilizes multiple tools and modalities to make the therapy process unique to the individual.

Finances: Cost per Session: \$100 - \$115. Sliding Scale: Yes. Pay By: Cash, Check, Mastercard, Visa. Accepted Insurance Plans, Anthem, BlueCross and BlueShield, CareSource, CareSource HIP, MHS, Medicaid, anthem HIP, traditional Medicaid. She accepts all forms of Medicaid and HIP and some HSA debit cards, sliding scale and cash payments. She does not bill private insurance.
